This document contains important information about limitations for PowerExchange for Snowflake.

Known Limitations

The following table describes known limitations:

CR	Description
OCON-10834	You cannot parameterize connection properties other than the connection name and Database/Schema.
OCON-10832	You cannot parameterize the source and target session properties.
OCON-10825	You cannot use the OR operator in a filter condition.
OCON-10822	After you import a table in the Designer, if you add constraints to the table, you must reimport the table to reflect the changes.
OCON-10814	You cannot partition data when you read from or write to Snowflake.
OCON-10812	You cannot read data from or write data to a table if the table name has small or mixed case letters. Workaround: Use only uppercase letters in the source and target table names.
OCON-10810	If you do not define a primary key in the target table, the mapping fails to delete record from or update record in the target table.
OCON-10486	The PowerCenter Integration Service writes incorrect target statistics after performing an insert, update, or delete operation.
